differing sizes and standards, with a wide variety of equipment and facilities. But there is one thing they have in common and that is that they all have a floor.

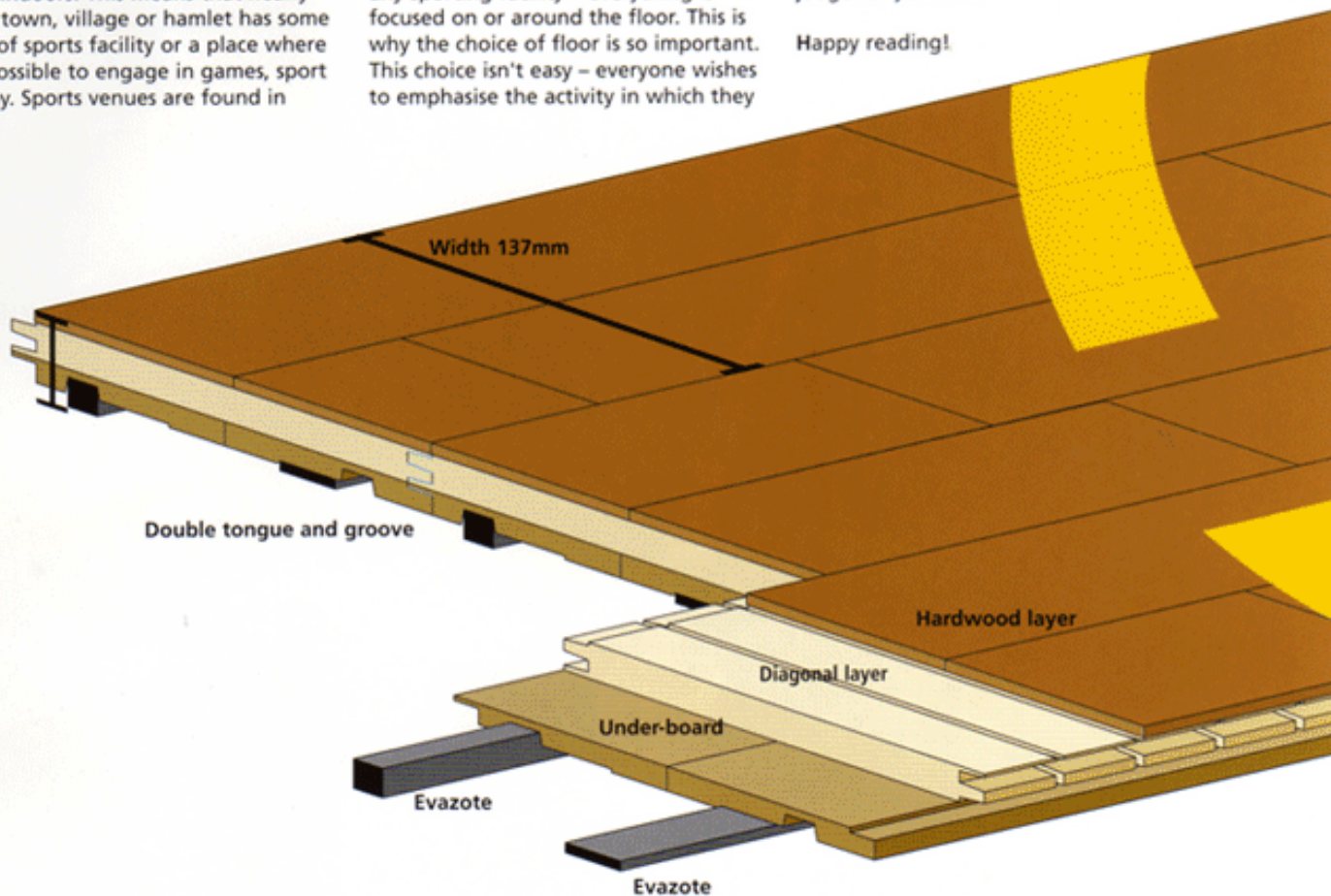
