

9. Surface maintenance

9.1 Cleaning the surface:

The surface must be regularly cleaned in order to eliminate animal excrements, chewing gum, or other accidental spills.

The following is a few cleaning instructions:

Caution: Never use a solvent.

Bird excrements:

Use a water spray and a hand brush as necessary and brush with care the soiled location.

Chewing gum:

Use a small quantity of ice on the surface in order to harden the substance and scrape it with a metallic spatula. The chewing gum crumbles once frozen.

As a last resort only, use nitrogen based SPRAY GEL for carpets without solvent.

Major damage or Spring cleanin

Use a stream of water oriented towards the exterior of the field to discard debris and residues.

Accidental spills of latex pain

Rinse immediately with a stream of water. Do not let the paint dry.

9.2 Brushing the surface

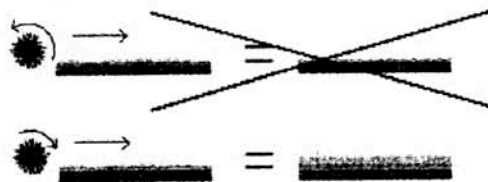


Figure 1. Influence brushing orientation

This step is to brush the fibers in order to straighten them and avoid that the fibers flatten. Naturally, the fibers have an inclination direction, it is therefore important that the direction of brushing rotation is opposite to the fibers inclination to avoid increasing the fibers flattening (figure 1).
